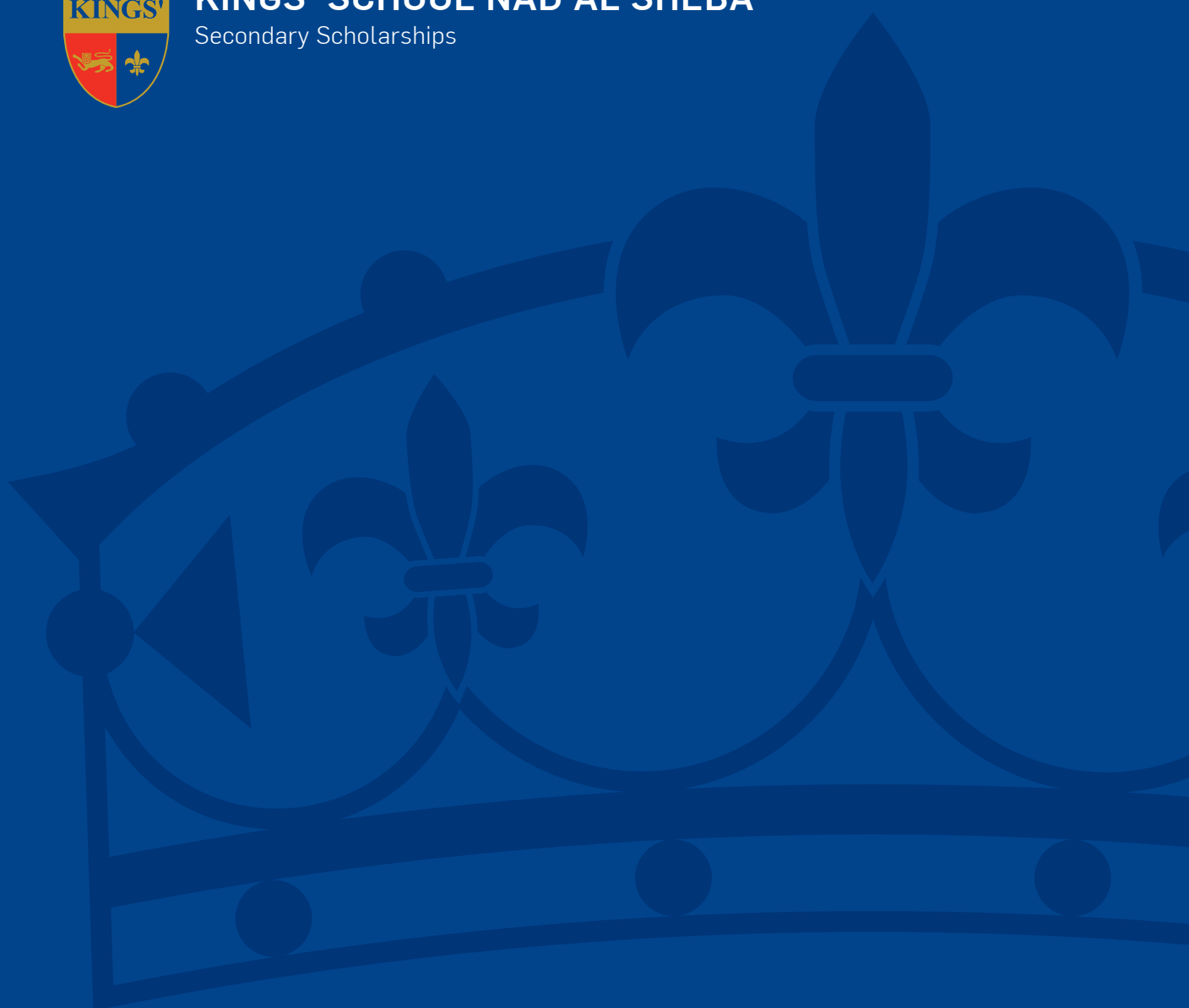

Kings' Scholarships are designed to recognise our students' outstanding talents and to enable them to access the outstanding educational provision and facilities here at Kings' School Nad Al Sheba Secondary.

Cultural, Academic, Arts, and Sports scholarships are available and apply for the duration of the student's time at Kings' School Nad Al Sheba as long as the student continues to perform at a high level and uphold the school values.

The Kings' Scholarship is not awarded to students before Year 8 and are limited in number. They are

awarded for the duration of the student's time at Kings' School Nad Al Sheba. Scholarships may be withdrawn if it becomes apparent that the student to whom an award was made is not making a significant contribution to the academic life of the school or making the most of the opportunities available to him or her.

Year 7 - 11 Entry | (Age 11 to 16)

Students will be invited to write 250 words explaining why they believe they deserve an Academic Scholarship and will have the opportunity to complement this with supporting documents.

The scholarship is granted for the duration of the key stage and will be extended automatically if they maintain high levels of academic performance.

Scholarships may be withdrawn if it becomes apparent that the student to whom an award was made is not making a significant contribution to the academic life of the school or making the most of the opportunities available to them.

SPORT SCHOLARSHIPS

What are the benefits?

- Participation in an intellectual sport development programme, looking at researching wider issues in sport and theory behind performance.
- Special guidance and advice on physical performance and conditioning, including specialist training programmes where appropriate.
- Mentoring by the head of their particular sport(s) and offered guidance and technical support where appropriate.
- Monitoring with regards to lifestyle, academic commitments, and offered support where appropriate that includes liaison with governing bodies and academies.

Who can apply?

Sports Scholarships are awarded to those students who can demonstrate the commitment, achievement, and potential to be a top sportsman/women in any area of sport. There are a limited number of Sport Scholarships available.

What we expect?

Sports Scholars are ambassadors for sport and are expected to make a full contribution to the sporting life of the school and will demonstrate team leadership skills. They are role models to their peers and are expected to demonstrate an outstanding commitment to the Kings' values at all times.

Sports Scholars will also be expected to be active members of the wider school life, particularly in the following areas:

• Enrichment

Be a sport champion who promotes and supports the development of their sport across the school and wider community.

This will include, and not be limited to - leading school sport events to promote sport, represent/lead the school teams across Dubai in competitive events, support with training and guidance for younger sport team members.

• Leadership

Captain teams in their area of sport and/or demonstrate leadership characteristics to support their team mates, work with first team coaches to lead training sessions.

• Community

Launch an initiative across the school community that drives sporting excellence and development opportunities for the student sporting community.

• Futures and careers

Contribute to the design of our future career pathways programme by researching relevant speakers, workshops and online career opportunities that will inspire fellow students.

ARTS SCHOLARSHIPS

What are the benefits?

Art

- Specialist guidance and advice on artistic and creative development, including specialist art courses where appropriate.
- Advice on and encouragement to enter local and national art competitions when the opportunities arise.
- Support in the development of portfolios for entry to higher education and further education art courses.
- Priority access to specialist ECA options.

Drama

- To be at the forefront of the dramatic and cultural life of the school. The Drama Department showcases a variety of events across the year and through these, Drama Scholars will have opportunities to participate both as a performer and behind the scenes.
- To broaden their dramatic experiences in other areas, which could include directing, writing, stage management and other technical areas as well as access to drama workshops and visits to a range of live theatre opportunities.

Music

- To be at the forefront of the musical and cultural life of the school as well as to access a growing number of opportunities to perform in events outside of school.
- To broaden their musical experiences in a number of areas, which could include conducting classes, developing skills or accessing other instruments, access to masterclasses, trips, and visits.

What are the benefits?

The key goal for an Arts Scholar is to be at the forefront of the cultural life at Kings' School Nad Al Sheba. They will be role models to their peers and will be expected to demonstrate an outstanding commitment to the Kings' values at all times.

Art Scholars will also be expected to be active members of the wider school life, particularly in the following areas:

• Enrichment

Be a subject champion who promotes and supports the development of the arts across the school and wider community.

This will include, and not be limited to - representing the school in the arts through national and international competitions, support the promotion of the arts across the school by leading events and supporting young talent to grow their skills.

• Leadership

Support the student community by leading opportunities to build a passion for the arts and participate in new experiences.

Take part in our teacher-student learning partnerships to share their talent across the community.

• Community

Launch an initiative across the school community that drives further curiosity into the arts and provides opportunities for students to develop their skills and subject passion.

• Futures and careers

Contribute to the design of our future career pathways programme by researching relevant speakers, workshops and online career opportunities that will inspire fellow students.

Art indicators of suitability

- Applicants must present a portfolio of work that demonstrates a mature and developed ability to draw, as well as to showcase creativity and imagination. Applicants will possess an enthusiasm for experimenting with new methods and media in art and have a genuine interest in art and artists.
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Drama indicators of suitability

- Applicants will have a proven track record of performing at a high level in front of large audiences. Applicants need to demonstrate their wider commitment to the arts and they must be motivated, positive, and effective communicators.
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Music indicators of suitability

- Applicants should generally be of Grade 3+ on one instrument (including voice) and should offer another instrument.

KINGS' SCHOLARSHIPS

Who can apply?

The Kings' Scholarship is awarded to students who have consistently represented the values of the school; Kindness, Skills, Never give up, Ambition, and Success by actively contributing to school life across a wide range of activities, positively seeking to make a difference to their community or raising awareness of the needs of others. This student is a role model to others, whose soft-skills of empathy, communication, team-work, and tolerance mark them out as a key member of our community.

The Kings' Scholarship will also be available to students who demonstrate excellence in the key skills embedded throughout our curriculum - Enterprise/Innovation/Creativity/Self management. These skills will be effectively used to raise the skills of others, inspire a growth mindset, and encourage a risk-taking attitude to try new skills.

A limited number of Kings' Scholarships will be awarded each year and applications will only be accepted for students in Years 8, 9 or 10.

What are the benefits?

Kings' Scholars can look forward to taking a leading role participating in the ECA Opportunities programme.

Kings' Scholars will benefit from:

- A leadership mentor from the Senior Leadership Team.
- Access to leadership/skills development programmes.
- Support in developing their other talents.
- Opportunities to lead aspects of school life.
- Access to international recognised programmes, such as Expedition UAE/The Duke of Edinburgh Award/wider curricular award programmes.

What we expect?

Kings' Scholars need to be fully committed to the life of the school and take opportunities to lead and to contribute to improving their community, or the communities of others.

Furthermore, Kings' Scholars are expected to carry out positions of responsibility within school events and raise awareness of key worldwide events/goals such as the sustainable world development goals.

Kings' scholars will also be expected to be active members of the wider school life, particularly in the following areas:
